WALDO GIRL was hustled from the start, quickly sped clear, took an awkward stride leaving the backstretch, dictated terms through the turn, responded well when asked at the quarter-pole, extended the advantage under a few taps of a right-handed whip, drew off into the final furlong, had the rider take a peek behind him outside the sixteenth-pole then was eased up while much the best. THE HOUSE OF ROME was ridden along at the rear, raced three to four wide on the turn and was second best. ONE BROADWAY QUEEN settled just off the pace, dropped back near the half-mile pole, lugged out a bit leaving the backstretch, went four then three wide on the turn and came up empty while able to get the show. TOUGH IRISH ANGEL broke a bit slow, settled while off the rail, raced between horses into the turn, dropped to the inside near the five-sixteenths pole and had nothing left. IONA was ridden along on the outside, advanced passing the half-mile pole, chased three then two wide on the turn and faded. JESS COOLER ONLINE raced towards the rear, saved ground on the turn and faltered.
