PARADE LEADER moved to the rail early, continued inside while advancing, was steered out four wide inside the three-sixteenths marker, collared KEATS and drew out. GRAEME HALL never far back, ranged up three wide nearing the the drive, loomed a threat and while no match for the winner was game for second. KEATS clear early, got headed late and missed second. OAK HALL steadied inside GRAEME HALL nearing the first turn, recovered to save ground, advanced from the rail around the second turn, appeared a threat and then weakened late. FIGHT FOR ALLY bumped with KISS A NATIVE after the start, recovered to stalk KEATS until before the drive and faded inside the final furlong. KISS A NATIVE hit the gate at the break, veered out into FIGHT FOR ALLY and then was never a threat. LORD JIM (ARG) raced close up until nearing the drive and gave way after six furlongs. VALHOL dropped back steadily in a dull effort. SAN PEDRO always back, was distanced.
