FOIST vied for the lead from the rail, got out footed by VOLOBEE(FR) around the second turn, bid along the rail for the drive, regained the lead and proved best under strong handling. VOLOBEE (FR) vied outside FOIST early, got clear while off the rail down the backstretch, was headed in upper stretch then was out kicked to the wire. AFTERNOON DREAMS settled along the inside, moved out nearing the furlong marker and was gaining late. RUNAWAY SREVA lunged at the break, was reserved until the second turn and was no real threat. PAD THE WALLET forward to the drive, gave way. TREE CHOPPER showed little.
