Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf in 2011-2012, allowed 2 lbs, Two races at a mile or over on the turf other than maiden or claiming, allowed 4 lbs, One such race, allowed 6 lbs. If more than fourteen (14) entries pass the entry box, preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest career earnings. Different owners have equal draw according to earnings. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY.

SUNDAY'S CHILD was rated while two to three wide on the first turn, became very eager when SCRATCHMYBACKHONEY moved up outside of her near the five-eighths pole, dropped back while in tight leaving the backstretch, went two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, made a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, battled gamely in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. SHE'S PRADO'S IDOL set the pace through tepid fractions, bumped with SCRATCHMYBACKHONEY leaving the backstretch then steadied, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, re-bid near the three-sixteenths pole, battled gamely in the final furlong and just missed in an unlucky trip. LITTLE MS PROTOCOL raced five wide while just off heels early on the first turn, dropped to three wide shortly thereafter, settled off the pace, advanced four then five wide on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, tried to keep INSINCERELY YOURS behind SUNDAY'S CHILD and finished willingly for the show. INSINCERELY YOURS raced three wide into the first turn then dropped to the inside, settled off the pace, moved closer while off the rail on the far turn, swung out at the quarter-pole, was put to a drive while behind SUNDAY'S CHILD in upper stretch, lacked room off that rivals heels near the furlong marker and finished willingly but missed the show. LINDOMO was carried six wide early on the first turn then dropped to five wide, settled just off the pace, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied two to three wide on the far turn and tired. LEAHA'S PRINCESS went three wide on the first turn, contested the pace, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, was in tight leaving the backstretch and came up empty. SCRATCHMYBACKHONEY was rank into the first turn, swerved five wide then dropped to

four wide while still difficult to control, moved up to contest the lead early on the backstretch, bumped with SHE'S PRADO'S IDOL leaving the backstretch and capitulated. TICA CALIENTE went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. MISS HELEN JAY raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, lagged at the rear of the field, went three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and was no factor. GOOD GOSH GIRLY went six then five wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was ridden along while five wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. (Rail at 15 Feet)
