Footnotes

URKEL went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, advanced three wide early on the far turn, dropped to the inside late on that bend, angled out at the quarter-pole, rallied to the lead passing the furlong marker and inched clear under strong urging. OUTRIGHT VENTURE broke out at the start, lingered well back in the field, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong and finished willingly for the place. RED FURY went six wide early on the first turn then dropped to four wide, tracked the pace on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn, took the lead in upper stretch, lost the advantage near the furlong marker and weakened while able to get the show. HERE COMES JUNIOR prompted the pace on the inside of the leader, moved out leaving the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths pole, vied into upper stretch and tired. TRAVELING STONE broke a bit awkwardly, went five wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, went three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide late on that bend, came six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. ELAINES DRAMA raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, set the pace, vied off the rail on the far turn and gave way. MOUSKOURI went four wide on the first turn, lingered well back, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. SARA'S BABY BROWN raced three wide on the first turn, was urged some on the backstretch, came up empty on the far turn and faded. MR. COOL PAPA broke about three lengths slow then ducked in, moved up while rank on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and stopped. NITE CRUISER broke out at the start, went seven then six wide on the first turn, dropped back on the backstretch and faltered.
