EVEN THE SCORE eased to the rail before the first turn, remained inside while advancing, moved out midway around the second turn, finished gamely and proved best. DISCREET HERO restrained just off WHATA BRAINSTORM from early on, bid outside that one around the second turn, gained the edge turning for home and then could not hold on. SEAINSKY angled to the rail nearing the first turn, continued inside until the drive, angled out before mid stretch and then did not have enough late. WHATA BRAINSTORM set a pressured pace, responded when headed and gave way grudgingly. DEVIL TIME trailed until before the drive and then improved position outside. GOLD TANGO forward placed between foes, had no response when asked. SKATE AWAY off a step slow, settled early, made a four wide middle move and then flattened out.
