BERRY VALID settled on the outside, raced two then three wide early on the turn, moved to four wide in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, rallied under strong hand urging in upper stretch, closed strongly on the outside and got up late under a vigorous hand ride. SULTRY WISPER tracked the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn, made a bid outside the quarter-pole, battled gamely with KOOKOOROTCHA in the stretch, defeated that rival for the place but was denied by the winner in a three-way photo. LUCKY WOMAN settled off the pace while under some urging, raced three wide on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and closed well but just missed. KOOKOOROTCHA broke alertly and set the pace, vied off the rail on the turn, dueled with SULTRY WISPER in the stretch and was outfinished late. O NIGHT DIVINE was a bit reluctant to load, settled at the rear of the field, raced two then three wide on the turn, moved out under left hand urging in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and finished with good late energy. MY ANNA ROSE was urged along while off the pace, came up empty while inside on the turn and faded.
