Footnotes

KARMA DISTRACTION raced off the rail on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, closed well to gain the lead passing the three-sixteenths pole, inched clear into the final furlong and held under mostly hand urging. TOTAL GENTLEMAN bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came under a strong left-handed whip in upper stretch, closed well to loom a threat on the outside, switched to a right-handed whip passing the furlong marker, drew alongside the winner but couldn't get by. CLASS CLOWN set the clear pace while off the inside, opened a large lead on the backstretch, dropped to the rail on the far turn, was collared passing the three-sixteenths pole and tired while well clear for the show. MAYOR TOM raced off the rail on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. PLEASANT CHIEF raced three wide on the first turn, followed the clear leader from second, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and came up empty. POPLARSAIN was last away, saved ground on the first turn, dropped well behind the field, came three wide into the stretch and never reached contention. MEETMEATTHEBANK settled on the inside, was urged along while continuing to save ground on the far turn and faded. CULLEN'S TWILIGHT bumped lightly with a rival at the start, lingered well back in the field, raced three then two wide on the far turn and showed little.
