### Footnotes

BUBBLING SPRINGS dropped to the inside entering the first turn, saved ground on that turn, settled nicely off the pace, ranged up while two then three wide on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, rallied into the final furlong and closed well to get up in the final sixteenth. THE DEUCE IS LOOSE was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when set down in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. RECTOR raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to secure the show. CORNICELLI raced four wide into the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, settled off the pace, advanced while off the rail on the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. WAR BRIDLE raced six then five wide early on the first turn, dropped to four wide late on that turn, settled near the back, was urged along while three then two wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. MR. ROAD WARRIOR raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and came up empty. HANNAS AGENDA was well placed just off the pace, raced inside while urged along on the far turn and had nothing left. MAGNET COVE raced five then four wide early on the first turn, dropped to one off the rail late on that turn, fell well behind and was pulled up then walked off.
