Footnotes

BABY AFLEET saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, came under some urging midway down the backstretch, was urged along while towards the inside on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, rallied to the lead passing the furlong marker then drew clear under steady urging. GOWDEN MILE was unhurried at the rear while saving ground, came off the rail at the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. SHERAGUSKA raced four wide on the first turn, moved up with five furlongs to run, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, battled into the final furlong and weakened while able to get the show. BAYLAND set the pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and tired. J. BURLE bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn, dropped to the inside at the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. ITSALLBOUTTHECHASE was caught five wide on the first turn, moved up on the outside near the five-eighths pole then dropped back again, was ridden along while four to five wide on the turn and failed to rally. SHEKINAH raced three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace, was asked when joined by rivals on the outside around the five-eighths pole, drew even with the leader leaving the backstretch, vied off the rail on the far turn and gave way. HUNT FOR COLLEEN raced three wide on both turns and failed to threaten. CLOSE TO MY HEART bumped with a rival at the start, was rank into the first turn, raced up close to the pace, went three wide on the far turn and came up empty.
