DOS DE BASTOS was hustled to the lead, raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the pace through moderate fractions, was asked for his best in upper stretch and held under a strong hand ride. ZANDER ZONE was eager while rated early, tracked the pace on the outside, was asked outside the quarter-pole, pursued the winner under a drive in the stretch and finished willingly for the place. APPROVETHISMESSAGE broke a bit slow, went two to three wide on the first turn, was reserved near the back, moved up with a half-mile to run, came under urging while between horses on the far turn, shifted three wide late on that bend and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. SILVER ROCKET MAN went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide late on that bend and failed to rally. THE THIRD ACE was reserved on the inside, moved closer with a half-mile to run, chased along the rail on the far turn and came up empty. FLYING BUTTERFLY was ridden along throughout, raced in the two path on the turns and was no factor. ABBYS PROMISE went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn and stopped.
