ALLEN'S OOP rated well off the leader, took over in upper stretch, responded when challenged by TAKE NOTE OF ME nearing the sixteenth marker and proved best under strong handling. TAKE NOTE OF ME settled from the rail, continued inside for the drive, appeared a serious threat a sixteenth out and was out kicked to the wire. ECTON PARK saved ground while unhurried, eased out for the drive, split rivals inside the final sixteenth and lacked the needed finish. ELABORATE raced off the rail while unhurried, bid in upper stretch and failed to sustain his bid. GOLDEN MISSILE reserved early, made a five wide middle move around the second turn and flattened out. NITE DREAMER was back early and outrun. WILD IMAGINATION sprinted clear quickly, set the pace for six furlongs and faltered once overtaken. PLEASANT BREEZE wide early, dropped back steadily.
