Footnotes

WEAR crossed to the inside before the first turn, vied for the lead, got clear entering the backstretch, remained clear for the drive and proved best under strong handling. HIGH WIRE forwardly placed off the rail, bid four wide nearing the drive, closed willingly but did not have enough late. CRAFTY NAT prominent from the inside, eased out for the drive, loomed in mid stretch and then could not continue on. VOLOBEE (FR) close up from the inside, eased out in upper stretch and then lacked a late punch. BIDDING PRO reserved, angled out in the lane and could make little impact. MIDNIGHT RUN maintained an even position. SHIBUI was outrun. PLATINUM HAWK showed little. ALUGA ISLAND vied outside WEAR early, remained a threat until before the drive and then stopped. TEN DREAMS was never dangerous.
