MAJHOOD raced four wide into the first turn then dropped to the inside, was well rated on a clear lead, responded well when asked near the quarter-pole, extended the advantage under strong hand urging and proved much the best while eased up in the final strides. BRAVO WHISKEY raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled in the second flight, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came under a full out drive in upper stretch and secured the place while no match for the winner. ATOMIC FORCE was asked a bit from the gate, followed the clear leader from second, chased that rival on the far turn and tired while able to get the show. ROCK HARD raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. HAZARDS OF LOVE steadied while against the rail early on the first turn, settled on the inside, steadied again while in tight leaving the backstretch, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty. TUCKY was reserved at the back of the field while near the inside, moved off the rail on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, was put to the whip shortly thereafter and failed to threaten. BUBBLING SPRINGS broke a bit awkwardly, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and faded.
