FOREVER JENNY was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied under a right-handed whip, closed well to get the lead just inside the furlong marker then edged clear under steady urging. MISS DANGEROUS was urged along on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, lost the advantage just inside the furlong marker and was outfinished while able to get the place. RAINY DAY MUSIC was urged along while off the pace, dropped in a bit leaving the backstretch, steadied slightly near the three-eighths pole, saved ground into the stretch, moved out under left hand urging outside the furlong marker and lacked the needed response while up for the show. SHE CAN FLY was urged along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn, came off the rail approaching the quarter-pole, lacked room passing the three-sixteenths pole and waited, found room shortly thereafter and also lacked the needed response. CRUNCH TIME was hustled to the lead, set the clear pace, controlled the action while inside on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. QUIETLY AMAZING lacked early speed, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. HER'S A GIRL was hustled from the start, chased the leader, raced three wide on the turn and tired. STORMIN IN PARIS was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty.
