ALARMING MR. G was never far back while racing on the outside, chased four then three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong and held well under strong urging. HERITAGE BAY was well placed just off the pace, raced a bit off the rail while urged some on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, chased the winner into the final furlong and finished willingly but was second best. SKY LILLY brushed with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, dropped back while three wide on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip in upper stretch, gained her best stride into the final furlong and finished well for the show then was eased up near the wire. COCKTAIL COVE bumped with a rival at the start then jostled with IDE BE A STAR, was urged along while off the pace, raced four wide early on the turn, dropped to one off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. IDE BE A STAR bumped with COCKTAIL COVE at the start, jostled between rivals early, was urged along near the back, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. WISHES FOR WISHERS was urged along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and came up empty. WHAT AN HONOR tracked the pace, ranged up while three then two wide on the turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, battled into the final furlong and weakened. EMMA'S CRISIS jostled with IDE BE A STAR after the start, raced in an uncomfortable position while between rivals, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole and was no factor.

OXFORD MISS set the pace while a bit off the rail, dropped to the inside on the turn, vied into the final furlong and gave way. INTISARA brushed with a rival at the start, raced well back in the field and showed little. LITTLE MISS FINE was urged along towards the inside, moved out on the turn, shifted five wide near the five-sixteenths pole and faded.
