Footnotes

MOUNTAIN JUSTICE broke out at the start, raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, went two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed well to draw alongside the leaders near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling. SICOMORO stalked the leader while on the inside of WHY NOT BE PERFECT, raced two to three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled determinedly into the final sixteenth and was outfinished late while able to get the place. TIMETABLE set the clear pace on the inside through moderate fractions, was set down in upper stretch, battled gamely into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished late then missed the place. TWILIGHT BAY settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, drafted behind the leaders on the far turn, came under urging near the quarter-pole, hesitated behind rivals passing the three-sixteenths pole, came under urging again shortly thereafter, lacked room behind rivals and steadied near the sixteenth-pole then lacked the needed kick. MUSICSTREET MENACE brushed with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled near the back of the field, was urged along on the far turn, gained ground in the stretch but never seriously threatened. WHY NOT BE PERFECT raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, chased three then four wide on the far turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch and weakened. JILLY FROM PHILLY angled in at the rear of the field, lagged at the back while saving ground and was no factor.
