WILDCAT ALY settled off the pace, moved closer while off the rail on the turn, rallied in upper stretch, closed strongly on the inside of the leader and got up late under strong urging. ILLUSION OF SPEED pressed the pace on the outside, took the lead passing the five-sixteenths pole, inched clear when set down in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. LOKOMAMMA was urged along on the inside, moved out near the five-sixteenths pole, swung five wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. OCEAN SURGE set the pace under pressure, lost the lead passing the five-sixteenths pole, battled into upper stretch then gave way. KIMBO lunged at the start and was off two lengths slow, was urged along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and tired.
