Footnotes

THEYCALLMEAWESOME settled between rivals, dropped in a bit leaving the backstretch, was asked passing the five-sixteenths pole, tried to force his way between horses coming to the quarter-pole, bumped JAYSIN'S SHADOW and failed to make the split, dropped to the inside, squeezed through along the rail at the furlong marker to make a bid, gained the advantage before the sixteenth-pole and drew clear under steady urging. FERNO was away well, set the pace, vied inside on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, had the winner squeeze through inside him at the furlong marker, lost the lead nearing the sixteenth-pole and proved no match for the winner while able to hold the place. JAYSIN'S SHADOW moved out then chased the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn, was bumped by the winner at the quarter-pole, pursued FERNO into the final furlong and weakened while able to get the show. ETBAUER'S ROUX broke two to three lengths slow, dropped well behind, went three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. BELROYALTY was coaxed along on the outside, chased three to four wide on the turn, dropped back in upper stretch and faltered. COOL CAT CAL was well placed just off the pace, dropped back quickly while green leaving the backstretch and retreated.
