Footnotes

AT THE PULPIT raced near the inside on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, ranged up late on that bend, was put to a drive after straightening into the stretch, made a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, inched clear into the final furlong and held gamely under strong urging. MADRIS settled towards the back, moved up with a half-mile to run, advanced inside on the far turn, tried to go inside the pacesetter after turning into the stretch, lacked room then altered course back to the outside, came between horses into the final furlong, drew alongside the winner late and just missed. AQTAAR went five then four wide on the first turn, moved up to prompt the pace on the outside, vied three then two wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch and was outfinished while just able to get the show. CALIPARI'S KITTEN dropped to the inside midway through the first turn, set the pace through tepid fractions, vied inside on the far turn, lost the lead at the quarter-pole, battled into the final furlong and was also outfinished then just missed the show. PURGENTIALITY saved ground on the first turn, was reserved under a tight hold, went three then four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide late on that bend, swung seven wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. HYPOTHETICAL went eight wide early on the first turn then dropped to six wide, was rated on the outside, chased five then four wide on the far turn and came up empty. CHALYBEATE SPRINGS went five then four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, raced four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. HA LONG BAY went three to four wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, raced two to three wide on the far turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and never reached contention. RITZ MASTER went seven wide early on the initial turn then dropped to five wide, tracked the pace, dropped back while four then three wide on the far turn and faded. BLACK RHINO went four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced two to three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to respond. (Rail at 25 Feet)
