Footnotes

OH WISE ONE raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the clear pace, was asked at the quarter-pole and drew off while ridden out. JENNY VIGNETTE broke about three lengths slow, dropped to the inside midway through the first turn, settled well off the pace, rallied inside on the far turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, chased the winner into upper stretch and proved no match while well clear for the place. FANCY TICKET went three to four wide on the first turn, dropped well off the pace, raced four wide early on the far turn, dropped to the two path near the five-sixteenths pole and was best of the rest. BACK TO LIFE broke a bit slow then was sluggish into stride, went three wide on both turns and was outrun. SOMETHING BLUE raced inside early on the first turn, shifted three wide while eager late on that bend, moved up on the outside to track the pace, dropped back while three to four wide on the far turn and stopped.
