Footnotes

GUSTAV BAY raced two to three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, made a bid outside the quarter-pole, gained the lead in upper stretch and held gamely under strong urging. WOODEND'S MAN was well placed on the inside, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, was urged along while behind rivals in upper stretch, moved out for clear running near the furlong marker, loomed a threat into the final sixteenth but couldn't get by the winner. PORTO BERMUDA was rated while under a right hold, drafted behind rivals while given free rein on the turn, raced behind horses in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. MYLEKA was well rated while setting the pace, lost the lead outside the quarter-pole, fought on willingly in the stretch but was outfinished. SUMKINDAHOUSBURNER raced three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, gained the lead outside the quarter-pole, lost the lead in upper stretch and weakened. ORDINARY TIME raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came under the whip near the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. EASY FROM THE GATE was reserved on the inside, moved closer near the half-mile pole, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn and failed to rally. K ONE FOUR raced four to five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three then four wide on the far turn, drifted out a bit inside the quarter-pole and also lacked the needed response.
