### Footnotes

SOUL MATE broke alertly, eased in going to the first turn, vied outside BOOGIE PIANO around the turn, made a quick move to shake clear down the backstretch, remained clear for the drive and proved best under strong handling. UNCORK never far back from along the inside, moved around BOOGIE PIANO to rally for the drive, ranged up before mid stretch and then could not overtake the winner. MONTARAZ unhurried, lacked a serious rally. BET ON THE RAINBOW devoid speed, showed late interest along the rail. LADY KREW restrained early, had no response. BOOGIE PIANO vied for the lead from the inside early, switched out down the backstretch when out sprinted, remained a threat until the drive and weakened. PASTEL COLOUR crossed to the inside early and then showed little. LA PIQUE DAME was always outrun. WILLING STAR trailed from early on and was eased midway down the backstretch.
