Footnotes

STARSILHOUETTE was rated on the inside while eager, waited behind horses from the five-sixteenths pole to the quarter-pole, was asked after turning into the stretch, moved out while chasing the leading duo, drew alongside MY MY MY MARIA coming to the sixteenth-pole and pulled clear late while drifting out under good handling. MY MY MY MARIA raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, set the pace along the rail through glacial fractions, was asked after straightening for the drive, battled with CAVE CREEKER into the final furlong, disposed of that rival but was quickly challenged by the winner and was outfinished while able to get the place. CAVE CREEKER broke a step slow, went three then two wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, raced off the rail on the far turn, waited passing the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid between horses at the top of the stretch, came under a drive, battled with MY MY MY MARIA into the final furlong and was outkicked by the top two while well clear for the show. CLEVER THIRTEEN went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, advanced five wide into the stretch, chased under a drive and came up empty. QUEENIE VIC went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer midway down the backstretch, raced three wide while still in hand on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, floated four wide into the stretch, was put to a drive shortly thereafter and capitulated. QUICK PRAISE settled while off the rail, drafted behind horses at the rear on the far turn, moved out some in upper stretch and failed to respond. (Rail at 25 Feet)
