**Footnotes**

PELHAM went five wide early on the first turn, dropped to three wide late on that bend, stalked the pace on outside, inched closer while three two to three wide on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, gained the lead shortly thereafter, edged clear under a vigorous drive and held under strong urging. CAJUN STREAKER went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, advanced late on that bend, came four wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong and finished willingly for the place while unable to threaten the winner. STEPHEN GOT BUD broke out at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced two then three wide on the far turn, followed CAJUN STREAKER past the five-sixteenths pole, swung five wide into the stretch, chased into the final furlong and also finished willingly but missed the place. EASY FROM THE GATE was reserved off the pace, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. GOLD SOUL was asked from the start, set the pace through moderate fractions, was asked at the quarter-pole, lost the lead to the winner and gave way. KASOS PRIDE was awkward into stride, went four wide on the first turn, was reserved on the outside at the back, raced four wide while under urging on the far turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and was no factor. SIXSIXTEEN was rated towards the inside, came under urging near the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch and capitulated. MATIAS broke a bit slow, lingered at the rear, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and never reached contention. THE ASHMAN broke a step slow, went four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, dropped back while three to four wide on the far turn and faltered.
