Footnotes

CORSO'S LAW bumped with ZEKE MCCOOL at the start, brushed with I'M IN CAT entering the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, engaged the leader on the far turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, edged clear in upper stretch, extended the advantage inside the furlong marker and proved much the best while drifting out badly late. LADIES LUV OUTLAWS went three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace, chased three wide on the far turn, pursued the winner in upper stretch and was second best. MONK E SEE went two then three wide on the first turn, lingered at the back, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, swung six wide into the stretch and got up for the show. ZEKE MCCOOL bumped with CORSO'S LAW at the start, was well placed just off the pace while towards the inside, chased on the far turn and tired. I'M IN CAT brushed with CORSO'S LAW entering the first turn, set the pace through moderate fractions, was coaxed along while inside on the far turn, lost the lead after turning into the stretch and gave way. BLAZING GRADUATE went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while four to five wide on the far turn and came up empty. BLUE DANGER went three then two wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was nudged along while inside on the far turn and failed to respond.
