YONAGUSKA STORM was away alertly, stalked the pace on the outside while under a snug hold, raced off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, was put to a drive, gained the lead outside the furlong marker, edged clear under urging then was eased up late. HERBAL PROSPECTOR showed good speed, set the pace on the inside, came off the rail at the quarter-pole, lost the lead outside the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner while able to get the place. BIGIN was well placed just off the pace, raced near the inside on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a drive while along the rail in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while clear for the show. HARD CASE settled just off the pace while on the outside, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. LOLLIPOPOP (ARG) brushed with a rival at the start, was taken in hand early then reserved off the pace, went four then three wide on the turn and failed to respond. STRONG AND TOUGH brushed with LOLLIPOPOP at the start, steadied off heels early, was reserved at the back, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail, shifted three wide late on the bend, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. ALI MACCOOL was reserved towards the back, dropped to the inside on the turn and was no factor.
