GUSTAV BAY was well placed just off the pace while off the inside, chased on the far turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong and held well under strong urging. HIGH HOPES E DAY had his stall door open prior to the start but made very little contact with the front of the gate, went four then three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, raced off the rail early on the far turn, shifted four wide near the three-eighths pole, moved to five wide near the five-sixteenths pole, continued five wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to garner the place. ZARB'S CHAMPION

broke open the front of his stall door prior to the start, went four then three wide on the first turn, moved up with a half-mile to run, rallied inside on the far turn, lacked room behind the pacesetter after straightening for the drive, moved out in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and flattened out while able to get the show. FIRST TO BINGO settled off the pace while near the inside, was urged along on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. COUSIN KEVIN was asked from the start, set the pace through quick fractions, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. BANTA went three to four wide on the first turn, settled in the front half of the field, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. SLIGEAUX BEAU broke a bit slow, raced four then three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went five then six wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. DALE'S BLUE HEAVEN saved ground on the first turn, raced at the back of the field, went five wide into the far turn then dropped to three wide, dropped further in outside the quarter-pole and was no factor. TAPPED TO THE MAX broke a bit slow, raced two to three wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, went three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide outside the five-sixteenths pole and also was no factor. SEA THE SOLDIER went six wide on the first turn, was urged along on the outside, raced four to five wide on the far turn and faded. BABY BWANA raced five wide on the first turn, settled on the inside of SEA THE SOLDIER, went four wide into the far turn then dropped in and retreated. CHA CHA RIOS broke through the gate prior to the start, went four wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, came up empty while three wide on the far turn and stopped.
