Footnotes

D'OR'S POWERSTROKE settled off the pace, angled in while moving up near the half-mile pole, raced towards the inside on the turn, was roused at the quarter-pole, chased under a drive in upper stretch, made a bid at the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under good handling. DELIGHTED DISCIPLE tracked the pace, chased three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. RILEY'S VOO DOO was coaxed along on the far outside, went five then four wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch and finished with good energy for the show. SPICEY WORLD was urged

along while well back in the field, went two then three wide on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch and finished well to just miss the show. SILENT PUNCH was urged along while just off the pace, made a bid while three to four wide on the turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened. PRINCE ROBEAR chased the pace, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied off the rail on the turn, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. OVER IT lunged at the start and broke a bit slow, settled well back in the field, went three then four wide on the turn, swung seven wide into the stretch and never reached contention. THUNDER CHOP moved up after the start, set the pace, vied inside on the turn and tired. PALMER TOUR settled while under some urging, raced three to four wide on the turn and failed to threaten. CY'S HOPE lacked speed while ridden along, moved in to save ground on the turn and was no factor. CLASSY SUAVE was hustled from the start then urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail approaching the quarter-pole and had nothing left. LAGNIAPPE IN B S L was urged along while just off the pace, chased four to five wide on the turn and capitulated.
