FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 by Saturday, February 23. \$750 to enter and \$750 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$3,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees.

\$150,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight : 123lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 at a mile or over since January 9, allowed 2 lbs, \$30,000 at a mile or over since then, allowed 4 lbs, \$25,000 at a mile or over since December 9, allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The New Orleans Ladies will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference will be given to horses that accumulated the highest total earnings in 2012-2013. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, February 23, 2013, with 13 nominations.

Footnotes

BELIEVE YOU CAN went to the front while into the bit, raced three then two wide on the first turn, was well rated on an easy lead, responded well when asked a bit at the quarter-pole, drew off under mild hand urging and won as the rider pleased. IMPOSING GRACE was reluctant to load, came away well, was intimidated when YOUNG AND LOVELY swerved in early, raced near the inside on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, moved into second at the top of the stretch, pursued the winner and was clearly second best. YOUNG AND LOVELY swerved in after the start, was eager in the early going then wrestled back early on the first turn, dropped back early on the backstretch, settled more kindly with five furlongs to run, raced inside leaving the backstretch, hesitated when in a bit tight coming to the three-eighths pole, shifted four wide in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, floated five wide into the stretch and narrowly earned the show. TOTALLY TUCKER went four wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace while on the outside, followed the winner while four then three wide on the far turn, dropped to one off the rail at the quarter-pole and came up empty then lost the show. MYRIAD tracked the pace on the outside, dropped back while urged along on the far turn and faded. PREMO'S STAR went three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace while between rivals, dropped back while three then two wide on the far turn and stopped.
