WIMBLEDON STAR showed good speed, contested the pace, moved clear passing the half-mile pole, dictated terms while off the rail on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, drifted out some under a drive in upper stretch and held under strong urging. ACACIAN SPICE was away alertly, disputed the pace, dropped back a bit passing the half-mile pole, raced inside on the turn, chased under a drive in upper stretch, inched closer to the winner in the final furlong but couldn't get by. FAVORITE FLAVOR settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the turn, chased under the whip in upper stretch and was outkicked while well clear for the show. DUSTY'S PLAYER showed speed then tracked the pace, chased three wide on the turn and tired. TRUE BREW was cantankerous in the post parade, came away last, settled towards the rear, shifted three wide near the three-eighths pole, came four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. LAY UP settled off the pace, was ridden along while off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. PHARME'S MISSTEAK settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor.
