VAUXHALL sprinted clear quickly, was well handled on the lead, opened up nearing mid stretch and proved best while kept to the task. WHITE CHOCOLATE under stout restraint early, eased up before the second turn, rallied four wide and then while no match for the winner was best of the rest. STORMY HOUR well back for a half, advanced around the second turn, angled out and then could make little impact. WATER MUSIC saved ground throughout and lacked a serious rally. LONG LEG LOU moved to the rail entering the first turn, continued inside until before the drive, swung out and hung. SKYLINE close up, tired. BLUE GURU stalked VAUXHALL until nearing the drive and then weakened. REDEYE GIRL wide early, dropped back.
