FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Saturday, February 25th; \$400 to enter; \$400 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 4% to fourth; 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$26,000 twice since November 10th, allowed 2 lbs, \$18,000 twice since then, 4 lbs, \$15,000 since then, allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses with the highest lifetime earnings. Different owners have equal draw according to earnings. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. Closed Saturday, February 25, 2012, with 37 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and 70 Yards.).

ICON IKE raced four to five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was roused while four then five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, took the lead near the furlong marker and proved best under confident handling. HERO OF ORDER brushed with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, set the pace, vied off the rail on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, lost the lead while drifting out a bit near the furlong marker, was straightened by the rider, drifted out again late and was outfinished while able to get the place. PURE TACTICS brushed with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, was well placed towards the front, swung five wide into the stretch, gained ground into the final furlong and finished willingly for the show. HAMMERS TERROR raced five wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, was asked while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch, made a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, was carried out late then steadied and missed. ROCK HARDER went

four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, made a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, was carried out late and also outfinished. BRAVO HABIBI settled off the pace, was roused on the far turn and lacked the needed response. CAPETOWN DEVIL raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went three wide on the far turn and failed to menace. ALEXANDER THEGREAT settled towards the rear while off the rail, was roused on the far turn and failed to threaten. WAYWARD SAILOR raced four wide on the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch, had a hole close near the three-sixteenths pole then gave way. ADENA'S CHANCE dropped back quickly at the start, lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on the turns and was no factor. TED'S FOLLY lingered well back in the field and showed little. Following a stewards' inquiry, HERO OF ORDER was disqualified from second and placed fourth for interference in deep stretch. (Rail at 0 Feet)
