RIO ROSE broke in and bumped with a rival, pressed then chased the leader, raced two to three wide on the turn, gained the lead at the quarter-pole, edged clear in upper stretch and held under strong urging. CLASSIC GOOD broke a bit slow, was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, chased the winner in the stretch and finished willingly for the place. LA BEIGNET was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. CLASSICGIZE charged the front of the gate just prior to the start, broke about five or six lengths behind the field, was ridden along near the rear, raced five wide into the turn then dropped in, chose to stay inside coming to the quarter-pole, gained ground along the rail in the stretch and finished well in a good effort. MILEY JEALOUS was away alertly, chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn and tired. IDE'S IN THE HOUSE bumped multiple times with WHOA BLACK BETTIE near the five-eighths pole, was urged along while off the pace, raced inside on the turn and failed to rally. LITTLE LADY LEXI was bumped at the start then taken up, raced well back while ridden along, went three to four wide on the turn, came six wide into

the stretch, drifted in nearing the furlong marker, moved back to the outside and failed to threaten. WHY SNOOP was ridden along while off the pace, advanced four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and weakened. RAIN CLOUD was bumped hard at the start, raced off the pace while ridden along and also failed to rally. RACHEL'S THUNDER bumped with a rival at the start, raced well back in the field, went three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor. WHOA BLACK BETTIE bumped multiple times with IDE'S IN THE HOUSE near the five-eighths pole then steadied, raced towards the inside on the turn and also was no factor. MISS LILLIS was away alertly, set the pace, moved clear passing the half-mile pole, lost the lead at the quarter-pole and gave way. MISS VALID DANCER bumped hard with rivals at the start, was ridden along in the front half of the field, dropped to the inside on the turn and came up empty.
