FOR THREE YEAR OLD FILLIES. Free nomination by Saturday, February 25th; \$400 to enter; \$400 additional to start.

Supplemental nominations of \$1,500 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs.

Non-winners of \$26,000 twice since November 10th, allowed 2 lbs, \$18,000 twice since then, allowed 4 lbs, \$15,000 since then, allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Preference to horses with the highest lifetime earnings. Different owners have equal draw according to earnings. Failure to draw into the race cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. Closed Saturday, February 25, 2012, with 26 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and 70 Yards.)

MIZ IDA broke out at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer while four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, rallied while well out in the course, gained the lead near the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong urging. FIREHOUSE RED broke out at the start, went four wide on the first turn, was reserved near the back while on the outside, advanced five then six wide on the far turn, came seven wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to get the place. CITIZEN ADVOCATE smashed through the front of the gate prior to the start, was rated just behind the leader, took the lead with a half-mile to run, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted out while under a drive, lost the lead near the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while just able to get the show. QUEEN TEUTA bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced four wide on the first turn, set the pace, lost the lead near the half-mile pole, went four wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and was also outfinished then missed the show. ROBI JO was fractious in the gate, went three to four wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, went four then five wide on the far turn, came eight wide into the stretch and finished willingly. RAINBOW BLOSSOM bumped lightly with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, went five wide on the far turn and lacked the needed kick. ITHINKISAWAPUDYCAT smashed through the front of the gate

prior to the start, settled off the pace while off the inside, moved closer on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, chased the leader into the final furlong and also lacked the needed kick. SPUN RIBBON was reluctant to load, raced three wide on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, went three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. DEVIOUS INTENT went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. KISS IN THE FOREST raced four wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear and faltered. (Rail at 0 Feet)
