

SHAWNEE COUNTRY angled to the rail early, settled early down the backstretch, moved to a striking position approaching the second turn, rallied five wide for the drive, collared GOLD FOR MY GAL nearing mid stretch, surged clear and proved best while kept to the task. EDEN LODGE angled to the rail early, was unhurried while out sprinted down the backstretch, found her best stride entering the drive, angled out and showed good late interest. ZOFTIG saved ground while settling, was asked nearing the drive, moved around foes and closed with good late energy. GOLD FOR MY GAL settled off the rail, made a four wide middle move, gained the lead before the drive and faltered late. HUMBLE CLERK devoid of early speed, split rivals nearing the drive and passed tiring foes. FRANKLY MY DEAR stalked NOVEMBER SLEW from early on, offered her best a quarter out and faltered along the rail. JOSTLE raced wide and was not a factor. CHILUKKI reserved off the leaders three wide, responded when asked nearing the second turn, offered her best a quarter out, stopped and was not abused. NOVEMBER SLEW clear early, was challenged quickly down the backstretch and then stopped badly through the lane.
