SPICEY WORLD chased the early pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced two to three wide on the turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed well to get up late. KOHNKE HILL ROAD rushed up after the start to take the lead, set the pace through solid fractions, vied near the inside on the turn, inched clear into the final furlong, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. PRINCE WILLIAM B settled on the outside, was urged some while three to four wide on the turn and lacked the needed kick while just able to get the show. SPEEDY PERILLOUX broke a bit slow, was ridden along near the back, raced inside early on the turn, shifted three wide inside the five-sixteenths pole, swung four wide into the stretch and finished willingly to just miss the show. STEELY RAN chased the pace on the outside, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, vied into upper stretch then weakened. LE SEUR was well placed just off the pace, raced inside while under urging on the turn and lacked the needed response. JUMP JUMP broke a bit slow, was ridden along while off the pace, raced two to three wide on the turn and failed to rally.
