Footnotes

AWESOME BET was reserved off the pace while towards the inside, came under some urging on the far turn, moved into a good striking position in upper stretch, was blocked behind a wall of horses passing the furlong marker, found room outside the sixteenth-pole then closed fast to gain a share of the victory. STRONG APPEAL was carried seven wide early on the first turn then dropped to five wide, raced towards the front on the outside, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn, rallied on the outside, closed well to get the lead late and shared the victory. SCUFF raced three then two wide on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, bided his time while near the inside on the far turn, shifted three wide at the top of the stretch, rallied into the final furlong, gained the lead near the sixteenth-pole but was denied in a three-way photo. SOCKAROOI raced four wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, moved further out once straightened for the drive and finished well. HOT FAUCET was a bit rank early, raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn, moved out near the furlong marker and also finished willingly. RESCUE FINANCING contested the early pace on the inside, swerved out leaving the first

turn, prompted HY LIME TIME on the outside, was asked for his best in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and weakened. HY LIME TIME was a bit rank early, moved up to take the lead with five furlongs to run, was asked for more in upper stretch, vied into the final furlong then tired. STARTER had the rider lose his whip entering the first turn, was reserved near the back while near the inside, saved ground on the far turn and failed to rally. DEVIL'S HAMMOCK was carried out leaving the first turn, tracked the pace, chased two then three wide on the far turn and capitulated. SPORTS DAY was rank in the early going, bore out to be six wide early on the initial turn, dropped to four wide midway through that turn, raced up close in the field, went three then four wide on the far turn and came up empty.
