EUR O SO BAD set the pace under pressure, inched clear while off the rail on the turn, was asked inside the three-sixteenths pole and drew off under a strong hand ride. HARBOR FOX was ridden along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and got up for the place. ALLEY SPROUT was urged along while off the pace, raced a bit off the rail on the turn and was best of the rest. VERY SPEIGHTSTOWN raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. WIMBLETON STAR was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. GOODWOOD GAL pressed the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn and tired. ELLUSIVE WILDCAT dropped well behind and was eased but walked off.
