MY FRIEND GAIL was caught five wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer as the field bunched outside the half-mile pole, advanced six then five wide on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, chased CHAMAKCHALLO into the final furlong and wore down that rival late under strong urging. CHAMAKCHALLO raced near the inside on the first turn, moved out early on the backstretch, was well placed just off the pace, made a bid while four wide on the far turn, inched clear into the final furlong, led into the final sixteenth but was caught while able to get the place. BLACK TULIP raced off the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to just get the show. MADE UP went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced between rivals while urged along on the far turn, was in a bit tight outside the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly to just miss the show. SNOW KISSED raced off the rail on the first turn, set the pace while well out in the course, vied three wide on the far turn and gave way. TAP IT TWICE was hustled from the start, raced four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased five then four wide on the far turn and weakened. PARADE OF HOMES went four wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging while three then two wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. PERFECT ECLIPSE was caught six

wide on the first turn, settled at the back of the field, went four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. WHERE'STHEDOVE raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace, drew even with the leader midway down the backstretch, vied towards the inside on the far turn and came up empty. CHAMPAGNE SPIRIT raced three wide early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, moved up outside the half-mile pole, dropped back while inside early on the far turn, was in tight outside the quarter-pole and failed to respond.
