UPTOWN BERTIE raced three wide on the first turn, was rated on the outside, chased four then three wide on the far turn, took the lead passing the furlong marker and drew clear under strong urging. FINALLYAREALLADY raced three then two wide on the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, chased three then two wide on the far turn, made a bid in upper stretch, battled into the final sixteenth and proved no match late while able to get the place. MILLE LUNA was well rated while setting the pace, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and weakened while clear for the show. URBANINI raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and came up empty. SHARILYN JEAN was reserved off the pace, went three wide on the far turn and also came up empty. JUST SAY HEY saved ground on the first turn, was well placed just off the pace, came under urging while a bit off the rail on the far turn and had nothing left. EXTRA COOL settled off the pace, was urged some on the backstretch, moved up near the half-mile pole, dropped back while inside on the far turn, drifted out in the stretch and faded.
