

MIGHTY settled early, was asked nearing the second turn, rallied from between rivals before the drive, swung out five wide turning for home, came four wide through the lane, ran down the leaders late and won going away. MORE THAN READY vied for the lead from early on, shook free in upper stretch, opened up a furlong out and while no match for the winner saved second. CAPTAIN STEVE settled from the rail, remained inside throughout and tried gamely. EXCHANGE RATE between foes early, moved up around the second turn, angled out for the drive, came three wide and lacked a late kick. PENINSULA prompted the pace until turning for home and faltered inside the final furlong. MORTAL CINCH three wide early, settled while unhurried, was asked around the second turn and could make little impact. IFITSTOBEITSUPTOME three wide early, was always back. ORO NEGRA raced close up from the rail until around the second turn and then dropped back. COUNTRY ONLY four wide early, stalked the leaders three wide until approaching the drive and gave way. TRIBUNAL lunged at the break, moved between foes around the first turn, raced within striking distance and then stopped suddenly.
