Footnotes

WHO LET THE CAT IN settled four wide down the backstretch, continued four wide around the turn, bid outside SEQUOIA KING turning for home, got clear and then held on. SMOKE WARNING moved to the inside early, continued inside until nearing the drive, rallied gamely but could not overtake the top one. MIDNIGHT PASS devoid speed, came inside around the turn, eased out for the drive, angled in while rallying and got up for the show. SEQUOIA KING forwardly placed three wide, bid midway around the turn, gained the edge, then had no final kick. UNLEASH THE POWER maintained an even position while outrun. ZAJESAL forwardly placed for a half, retreated. ADMIRAL HALSEY vied for the lead to before the drive, then gave way.
