STAKES Grindstone S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No Nomination fee. \$300 to enter and \$300 to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed of which, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to sixth through ninth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 on the turf since January 5th, allowed 2 lbs, \$30,000 on the turf since December 5th, allowed 4 lbs, \$25,000 on the turf since then, allowed 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to pass the entry box at the usual time of closing . NOTE: This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. High weights will be preferred. Different owners have equal draw according to weights. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY. Closed Saturday, February 19, 2011, with 31 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and 70 Yards.) (Rail at 16 feet).

### Footnotes

GREAT MILLS set the clear pace while under a good hold, drew off when asked in upper stretch and held sway while kept to the task. WILLCOX INN raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced near the inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, rallied on the outside, drifted out a bit inside the furlong marker and finished with good energy to get the place. MAVERICKING raced three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, bumped with ACTION READY in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. CLOSE ALLY went four to five wide on the first turn, was unhurried at the back of the field, raced off the rail on the far turn, swung four wide at the top of the stretch and improved position. ACES N KINGS raced two to three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four then three wide on the far turn and weakened. MOONBIE raced five wide into the first turn then dropped towards the inside, tracked the leader down the backstretch, chased three then two wide on the far turn and came up empty. ACTION READY raced four then three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging while two to three wide on the far turn, bumped with MAVERICKING in upper stretch and failed to rally. TRAGIC MAGIC settled towards the rear, saved ground on the turns and failed to threaten. (Rail at 16 Feet)
