MATTGETSNORESPECT raced well back in the field, moved out on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late. HUNTER VISION settled off the pace while under some urging, moved in leaving the backstretch, raced two then three wide on the turn, rallied into the final furlong and closed well to get the place. TOP CATS RANSOM sprinted clear after the start, set the pace while off the rail, had the rider lose her whip inside the quarter-pole, maintained a sizeable advantage into the final furlong but was caught. BURNING DIAMOND broke a bit slow, raced well back in the field while ridden along, was in tight near the half-mile pole, came three wide into the stretch, moved out near the three-sixteenths pole and finished with good energy. DONT CALL ME YOGI moved up after the start, raced off the pace while urged along, went four wide on the turn and

failed to rally. E Z BEN was hustled from the start then urged along while off the pace, raced near the inside on the turn and also failed to rally. PROMISETOMAKE IT broke out at the start, was ridden along on the outside, raced five wide on the turn, dropped to three wide just inside the five-sixteenths pole and failed to respond. SHELBY chased the solo leader, raced three then two wide on the turn and tired. WHAT SECRET lacked early speed, raced three then two wide on the turn and failed to threaten. DOMINICANO was ridden along towards the back, raced three then four wide on the turn, moved to five wide outside the quarter-pole and was no factor. RAHY BALBOA broke a bit slow, raced well back in the field and showed little. CHESTNUT PUNCH hesitated at the start and broke a bit slow, dropped well behind the field and was pulled up then walked off.
