Footnotes

BARRINGTON ROAD was rated just off the pace, ranged up while three wide on the far turn, gained the lead passing the five-sixteenths pole, edged clear under urging in upper stretch and drew away under steady handling. TAPATIVITY broke two to three lengths slow, lagged at the rear of the field, was urged along on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to get the place. RYS ALLEY CAT settled just off the pace, advanced four wide on the far turn, made a bid near the five-sixteenths pole, chased the winner into the final furlong and proved no match then was caught for the place. CALLINGAHARDTEN raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. TYCOON CAT raced three then two wide on the first turn, prompted the leader on the outside, drew even with that rival midway down the backstretch, vied off the rail on the far turn and tired. D' BANDITO was caught five wide early on the first turn then dropped towards the inside, raced under tight restraint while eager early on the backstretch, moved up towards the inside, was roused while off the rail on the far turn and came up empty. HUMOR'S PUNCH lunged at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. GIANT GRAND SLAM came out at the start, set the pace on the inside, dropped out midway through the far turn and faded. BROADLANDS lagged near the back of the field and showed little.
