SILVERBULLETDAY four wide early, remained outside while unhurried, moved up approaching the far turn, loomed boldly three wide a quarter out, gained the lead in mid stretch and edged clear late. RUNAWAY VENUS prominent from the inside, slipped through inside WALLENA turning for home, gained the lead between calls, tried hard when displaced and lasted for second. BRUSHED HALORY trailed until nearing the drive, was moved out five wide and closed late. WALLENA held the lead while racing off the rail, responded when collared and gave way grudgingly. MRSKNOWITALL saved ground while unhurried and failed to respond when put to pressure. GOLDEN ILLUSION raced close up while three wide and gave way after a half. BOOM TOWN GIRL close up early, dropped back and was not abused.
