CONQUISTADOR'S JOY settled off THE ONE WE KEPT from early on, bid midway down the backstretch, took over around the second turn and proved clearly best. GOOD HUMOR GAL allowed to settle, raced between foes down the backstretch, advanced along the rail around the second turn, eased out for the drive and was best of the rest. LACE CASTELLI trailed early and rallied late along the rail. SAD CAFE devoid speed, moved to the inside entering the first turn, eased out after turning for home and hung. SUGAR TOES unhurried, showed late interest wide. PIONEER GAL close up to the second turn, tired. CROWN ME LATER showed little. THE ONE WE KEPT clear early, stopped once headed. SANDY RIDGE dropped back.
