LORD OF THE ROSES showed good speed, set the pace, vied inside on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, disposed of TORO BRAVO approaching the furlong marker and held under steady urging. TIDE RISING raced just off the pace while on the inside, was taken up while lugging out a bit leaving the backstretch, clipped the heels of TORO BRAVO then checked, regained stride midway through the turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, angled out behind rivals and finished willingly for the place. TORO BRAVO stalked the pace on the outside, had TISE RISING clip his heels leaving the backstretch, made a bid outside the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch, battled with the winner while under a drive, lost touch with that rival near the furlong marker and weakened while clear for the show. EXPECT A FLYER settled just off the pace, ranged up while three wide on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, chased into upper stretch and came up empty. STRAY DOG was hustled from the start then urged along on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and was no factor. CITY ORDINANCE was slowest into stride, raced on the outside while ridden along, went four wide on the turn, dropped in at the quarter-pole and failed to threaten.
