KIMBERLITE PIPE bobbled just after the start, recovered, raced within striking distance while under restraint, moved out for room nearing the drive, angled to the rail approaching the furlong marker, came out a bit inside the final sixteenth and proved best under strong handling. ANSWER LIVELY three wide early, remained three wide while close up, loomed boldly completing six furlongs, tried hard to the wire and just missed while forced out a bit late. ECTON PARK saved ground early, dropped back around the final turn, rallied nearing the drive, angled out five wide and closed with good energy but was too late. VALHOL stalked ROYAL HERO from early on, ranged up outside that one completing six furlongs, gained command turning for home, steadied slightly when KIMBERLITE PIPE came out inside the final sixteenth and faded. GENERAL CHALLENGE lunged at the start, recovered, was allowed to settle, commenced his rally entering the final turn, came five wide around the turn, continued out for the drive and came up empty. STELLAR BRUSH back early, was asked for run nearing the final turn, advanced four wide around the turn and failed to sustain his bid. SILVER CHADRA saved ground while unhurried, rallied before the drive, eased out and flattened out. ROYAL HERO set the pace for six furlongs, dropped back when headed and was not abused late. The rider of VALHOL claimed foul in deep stretch against the riders of KIMBERLITE PIPE and ANSWER LIVELY for alleged interference in the final sixteenth. The claim of foul was not allowed.
